I HAVE CONCLUDED...

I MUST RECOGNIZE AND ABIDE IN GOD'S LOVE - Jo 3:16; 1:9-12; I Jo 4:8, 18-19

- God Loves What He Created
...He came in Person to demonstrate His love
- Since He is Love, All His Directives Are Trustworthy
...We must be conditioned by Love
...We must be loved out of our fears

Whenever I feel fear/anxiety, I will let it redirect me to God's perfect love

I MUST REFERENCE AND ABANDON EVERYTHING TO THE PERSON OF CHRIST

- Christ Is God's Word on All That Concerns Me - Jo 1:1-4
...He has the pre-eminence in all matters - Col 1:18
...Every life event is an escort to Christ - Co 3:17
- We Abide in Him in order to Abandon to Him
...So that we may know Him - Jo 17:3; Phil 3:8
- He Is the Light That Makes It Possible for Us to See - Jo 1:4-5, 9; 8:12
...He opens our eyes to His purposes in all that affects us - Ro 8:28-29; 11:36

Whenever I think life is meaningless, I will let such thoughts re-direct me to reference and abandon that moment to Him

I MUST RESIST AND ANSWER THE LIE OF SEPARATION WITH THE TRUTH

- The Word of God became flesh - Jo 1:14
...Christ is full and perfect in Godhood and manhood
...He perfectly joins together Deity and humanity; uncreated and created
- He came to be with us so that He might live within us - Jo 1:12; Col 1:27
...We have received the fullness of His Life - Jo 1:12,16; II Pet 1:4
..."just me" was replaced by "Christ in me" - Ga 2:20

Whenever I "feel" distance between God and me (seems like its "just me"), I will let it redirect me to Christ who lives in me, adequate for every need.
